5. Daniel Rusnak holds report and discussion about Willow Grove Master Fee Schedule as it relates to Annual passes.

- a. Anthony Borrow- mentions “mega-pass” option with collaboration of other surrounding cities for access to all Parks.

- b. John Cabrales states that WGP is corps leased property all revenue generated must be put back into the park.
- c. Anthony Borrow states that he recommends 2 free passes should be reduced to 1 per household.
- d. Lester Raborn- agrees passes should be 1 per household and wants to open up the passes for non-residential use
- e. Dan Nolan- states passes over 1 should be at a discounted price.
- f. Cheryl McClain- asked if before the new system was installed, there has been no way of tracking usage and frequency of residents into the Park.
- g. Lester Raborn- no one really knows what the positive impact of the new kiosk will be.
- h. Cheryl McClain- asks if the other surrounding cities will disclose their fee schedule for comparison for non-residential passes.
- i. Dan Nolan- wants to know how we could create a flat fee for all amenities for the park, one fee no matter the recreation usage.
- j. John Cabrales- clarifies enforcement against placard misuse moving forward.
- k. No recommendation made by the Committee until more information is provided.
